Speaker: Abdul-Fatawa Abdulai, Assistant Professor, UBC School of Nursing

Title: Development and application of destigmatizing design guidelines in sexual health-related technologies.

Technologies are increasingly used as complementary tools in managing sexual health-related conditions, yet many technologies designed to reduce stigma actually increase or perpetuate sexual health-related stigma. Despite stigma being a major issue in sexual health, how this concept is understood and addressed in the context of digital health technologies remains unknown. In this

presentation, I will discuss my recent research on the development and application of destigmatizing design guidelines based on a trauma-informed care framework. These guidelines are meant to serve as a guiding framework to support software designers to create destigmatizing technologies. This presentation will conclude with a call for a trauma-informed user-centred design, where trauma-informed, stigma-specific emotional and content-related design guidelines should be prioritized during sexual health technology design.
