Nursing Informatics: Integrating Care and Connection in a Digital World

The Pre-Conference Workshops hosted a variety of sessions ranging from an Introduction to Nursing Informatics and the current Virtual Care trend, to Artificial Intelligence, Clinical Decision Support and User-Centred Design.
